Piloting

In each partner country (Poland, Czech Republic, Spain, Ireland and United Kingdom) pilot computer service training course has been organized. Trainers working in partner institutions conducted training using the COMTRAIN training program, which was a bit extended and adapted to each country national context.

The piloting has been assessed by the participants as very interesting. In the evaluation forms, many of them stated that this project should be continued and that follow-up for this training should be organized.

Multiplier event

In the framework of COMTRAIN project two multiplier events have been organized – first in Lancaster (24th February) and second in Rzeszow (20th April). The event in the UK has been attended by more than 60 participants and in Rzeszow by more than 40. The project has been presented to staff of training institutions. They were acknowledged by the training program developed in the project.

During the event, British and Polish partner presented also piloting on local level. The training program has been used in practical way during piloting.

According to the evaluation, participants stated that the event has been well organized and very interesting. Several participants working in training companies and associations told, that they are interested in conducting computer service training with COMTRAIN training program.

Final meeting in Rzeszów

The final meeting in the framework of COMTRAIN project has been organized in Rzeszów (Poland) on 7th-8th June 2018. The meeting has been attended by representatives of each partner in the project.

During the meeting piloting on local level performed in each partner country has been presented and discussed.

Partners summarized the project and discussed the final report. At the end of the meeting partners discussed also possible follow-up for COMTRAIN project. Partners agreed that this project should be continued and extended with e.g. on-line service with exercises for participants of training courses, on which they could use and fix knowledge and skills gained during training in practical way.
